The Details:

- The Stark Poll is conducted using best practices and methods to obtain statistically reliable and meaningful data.
- The Poll is based on 600 interviews, yielding an overall sampling error of 4.0%, with a 95% confidence level.
- The final sample is representative of the adult population of the county with close attention paid to respondent demographics & area representation.
- Data is analyzed by professional staff at CMOR and a final report is delivered that provides insights and recommendations and includes a comprehensive analysis and key findings. Presentation of results is available, as requested.
- CMOR conducts similar polls in surrounding counties allowing benchmarking between like agencies in different counties.
